Advanced Bookkeeping, Final Accounts Preparation and Management Accounting: Costing must have been completed before attempting the Synoptic course. It is recommended that Indirect Tax is also completed before the Synoptic course however this is not compulsory.

Final accounts Preparation is a follow on unit from Advanced Bookkeeping and therefore can not be studied before this.


You can start your studies with Advanced Bookkeeping, Management Accounting: Costing or Indirect Tax thus giving flexibility on your starting date as all courses will run again in the second half of 2020.
